Steve was awarded an MBE in 2004 for his services to social inclusion.

Muhammad trained as a Youth and Community Worker before going on to work as a Youth Worker and manage youth and community projects across Birmingham. His Ph.D. research is on Muslim organisations and youth work which led to the National Conferences on Muslim Youth Work in 2005 and 2006 and founded the Muslim Youthwork Foundation. He is currently a lecturer at the School of Education at Birmingham University.
